



Privacy Policy

Natty Interiors (“We/Us/Our”) respects the privacy of everyone who visits this website, nattyinteriors.com (“website”), and will only collect and use personal data in ways that are described here, and in a manner that is consistent with our obligations and your rights under the law. The term “you” refers to anyone who uses, visits, and views the website.

The person responsible for processing personal data within the meaning of the law is Natalia Potulna, trading under the name Natty Interiors, established in Den Haag and registered with the Chamber of Commerce under number 86001957.

By visiting and using the website, you accept and agree to be bound by this privacy policy. Your continued use of the website after posting of any changes to our Privacy Policy constitutes your acceptance of those changes and updates. You must not access or use the website if you do not wish to be bound by this Privacy Policy.

This Privacy Policy applies to all of the services offered by Natty Interiors.

1. What data do we collect?

1.1. In order to perform its services, it is necessary that Natty Interiors collects and stores a number of legally protected personal data from you. Below you will find an overview of the personal data that we process:

- Personal data: First and Last Name, email address, address, phone number, bank account number, etc.
 - Information about your computer’s Internet Protocol Address: “IP” address, browser information, Internet Service Provider’s information, operating system, browser type.)

2. How we collect your data?

2.1. We collect and process your personal data mainly to provide you with access to our services, and to help us improve them.

2.2. We may collect personal data about you from different sources, data including the following:

3. How will we use your data?

3.1. Natty Interiors collects your data for the following purposes only, namely:

- To be able to provide the product or service that you have applied for, in order to fulfil our contract with you
- For internal assessment and analysis and in order to protect our legitimate interest
- To fulfil our legal obligations
- In the developing and improving our products and services

3.2. From time to time, we may disclose your personal information (on a confidential basis) to agents and others that we use in the ordinary operation of our business, marketing and promotion, user experience research and surveys, website hosting and support, and maintenance.

3.3. We will only disclose your information to the extent required for the purpose of the third party providing services contracted to us so that we may service you. Your personal information will never be sold to any third party.

3.4. For legal reasons, we will share personal data with companies, organisations, or individuals out-side of Natty Interiors if we have a good-faith belief that access, use, preservation or disclosure of the data is reasonably necessary to:

- Meet any applicable law, regulation, legal process, or enforceable governmental request;
 - Enforce applicable terms of service, including investigation of potential violations;
 - Detect, prevent or otherwise address fraud;
 - Protect against harm to the right, property, or safety of Natty Interiors, our users, or the public as required or permitted by law.

4. Third-Party Links

Third-party links may be discovered on our site. These third-party links have their own privacy policy, which you agree to when you click on the link. We are not responsible nor do we accept responsibility for third-party links. Our liability covers us only on our site, and thus we do not accept liability for third-party links as we have no control over them.

5. Who we share your personal data with

The personal data you provide to Natty Interiors can only be provided to a third party with your permission and if this is necessary for the implementation of the purposes described above and/or the legal obligations (e.g. administrative and/or fiscal retention obligations). Natty Interiors never passes on your personal data to another party with whom no processing agreement has been concluded. Naturally, the necessary agreements are made with these parties (processors) to guarantee the security of your personal data.

6. How do we store your data?

6.1. We make sure to use reasonable measures to protect personal data. If you have reason to believe that your interaction with us is no longer secure, please immediately advise us.

6.2. We will not retain your personal data for longer than it is required for the maintenance of your relationship with us, or for any legal or regulatory requirements.

6.3. Locations outside the European Economic Area may be used for transferring data we collect about you. These data sites are for storing or processing of your information. The information we share outside the European Economic Area may be shared with staff based on the process and storage of said data. It may include such processes as processing a payment or offering support for your service or product needs. The staff processing or storing information may work for our suppliers outside the European Economic Area. By submitting your data to use you have agreed to this transfer and storage of data. We take all reasonable action to ensure the safety of your personal data in agreement with this Privacy Policy.

7. Marketing

7.1. The email address you provide for order processing will only be used to send you information and updates pertaining to the order. It may also be used to respond to your inquiries, and other requests or questions.

7.2. If you decide to opt-in to our mailing list, you will receive emails that may include our news, updates, related product or service information, etc. If at any time you would like to unsubscribe from receiving future emails, we include unsubscribe instructions at the bottom of each email or you may contact us via our website.

8. What are your data protection rights?

8.1. We would like to make sure you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

- The right to request copies of your personal data. We may charge you a small fee for this service
- The right to request that Natty Interiors corrects any information you believe is inaccurate
- The right to request Natty Interiors completes the information you believe is missing
- The right to request that Natty Interiors erases your personal data, under certain conditions

- The right to request that Natty Interiors restricts the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions
- The right to object to Natty Interiors' processing of your personal data, under certain conditions
- The right to request that Natty Interiors transfers the data that we have collected to another organization, or directly to you, under certain conditions

8.2. You may request Natty Interiors access to your personal data at any time. You can also request Natty Interiors to correct, supplement, delete or protect your personal data if it is incorrect, incomplete, or irrelevant, or if it is otherwise processed in violation of legal regulation. If permitted by law, Natty Interiors will ensure that your data (or part of it) is removed or adjusted within 10 working days.

9. What are cookies?

Cookies are text files placed on your computer/tablet/smartphone to collect standard Internet log information and visitor behavior information.
